Painting Supplies

Suggested Pigments to Use for Painting:

Red	Red Oxide Cadmium Red Medium
Green	Hookers' Green Winsor Green Sap Green
Blue	Ultramarine Blue Cerulean Blue
Yellow	Yellow Ochre Cadmium Yellow Permanent Yellow Deep
Brown	Burnt Umber Burnt Sienna Sepia
Pinks	Quinacridone Red Permanent Magenta or Quinacridone Violet Rose Madder
	Payne's Grey

Paper

- D'Arches watercolor paper use 140 or 300 lb (\$20 or \$10 per sheet. Also available in a pad, 12 x 16, \$40.00)
- D'Arches watercolor board/Canson Artboard \$6.65 a sheet

Brushes

- Three, small medium and large. I like Robert Simmons synthetic and I usually just use round brushes but flat can be good for stems. A total of one or two are all you need.

Drawing Supplies

Bristol or illustration board

Pencils

Erasers, kneaded or pink

Prismacolor pencils

Bring some Bristol paper or board to draw on, and a few pencils to sketch with, F or H or an HB are all good. Prismacolor colored pencils are excellent to work with, but you may also use other types. It is important to have really good paper, so you can erase if you have to!
