## Canebrake pitcher plant



## **Plant Botanical Name:**

Sarracenia rubra

## Plant Sub Species or Variety:

## ssp. Alabamenis

Often found with canebrake bamboo (Arundinaria gigantean), a native bamboo, *Sarracenia albamensis* is also known as the canebrake pitcher plant. Willids, this pitcher plant can reach up to 30 inches in height. One of the rarest native pitcher plants in the United States, *Sarracenia alabamenisis* is protect including the U.S. Endangered Species Act and the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES). In the 1960s, this plant could be Alabama, but due to significant habitat loss, today the canebrake pitcher plant is only found at 11 sites in only two counties in Alabama. Draining land for
