Across the United States, a growing number of schools and educational p

gardens, engaging in Farm to School activities, and integrating plant science into the curriculum. To support and expand these hands-on learning activities, we have developed this manual. The manual provides ways to build new infrastructure or reinvest in existing facilities such as greenhouses. Unfortunately, many school greenhouses are underutilized or only used when a dedicated teacher is enabling their use.

The United States Botanic Garden, the National Center for Appropriate Technology, and City Blossoms recognized the emerging need for user-friendly greenhouses for educational greenhouses and maximizing their potential. To that end, we have developed this introductory manual for educators wanting to better use greenhouses for programming. The manual includes lesson plans as well as basic information on layout and operations of a greenhouse (from start-up during the school year), growing from seed, seedling nutrition, identifying and treating disease and pest management in greenhouses, basic budgeting, and more.
