Anemone x hybrida 'Honorine Jobert' is an outstanding garden plant for the Mid-Atlantic region. It is an old garden hybrid and is sometimes sold as *Anemone Jobert* or *A. x hybrida* 'Alba.' Once established, it is relatively low maintenance and has showy white flowers from August through frost. When grown in good soil and protected from hot dry conditions and afternoon summer sun, it should eventually naturalize and spread into colonies up to two feet across. It does not prefer wet soils or particularly excessive winter dampness.
