Paphiopedilums are wonderful orchids for the home, requiring conditions normal in most residences. Indirect sun from an east, west or shaded southern window between 55 at night and 85 during day is needed along with about 60 percent humidity. In the home, humidity can be provided by a spray bottle or from a tray of pebbles in water. Repotting may be needed every couple of years, as most orchid potting mixtures break down rapidly. In addition to adequate light, a regular fertilizer application is required for health and flowering.
