This cultivar of the native boxelder stays under 30 feet, is not self-seeder, and has an outstanding display of chartreuse yellow leaves. It can take wet feet and also withstand some drought. Boxelder is relatively fast growing therefore weaker branching tree, so this specimen can suffer damage by ice or heavy snow.
