- 2 2H pencils
- 2 2B and/or 4B drawing pencils
- Small pocket pencil sharpener
- One set of permanent ink felt tip drawing pens various nib sizes (recommend Micron brand)
- 3-4 stumps and tortillions (thin tightly rolled paper used for blending)
- Small plastic 6" ruler
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 1 pink pearl eraser

- 4-6 small, wide mouthed, lidded air-tight containers unbreakable containers for dye and dye washes
